- Showing the engagement history to include current gift & life time gift- include reoccurring gift
- Donor information shows number of donations, total amount given per year, broken down per year
- Provides search-ability for fundraising events
- Provides option to donate to event even if you don't attend

- Donors have to pay a fee to donate


Dipjar

Cashless donation jar and an integrated payments platform that enables donors to give on the spot anywhere your charity is fundraising

Donate easily in 3 steps.

- Users can use their credit cards to donate to their charities
- Using the Dipjar placed at points of purchase areas
- Connects via wi-fi
- Distributes the funds the next day to charities
- Available to rent for large events, monthly or yearly

- **1** Quick transactions
- 2 Dipjar makes a donation noise each time
- 3 Dipjar can be left at any location with wi-fi
- 4 Logo of the charity can be added to the Dipjar





V Callout - Good

- Can make a donation anywhere
- 3-easy steps to accept any card payments
- Funds transfers to charity next day
- Can place at events or leave at partnership places for seamless donating by customers at checkout




Invest spare change, invest while you bank, earn bonus investments, grow your knowledge and more.


Round Ups, Earn \$ for friends who join, **Reoccurring Donations**

Users can round up any purchase and invest it. Users get a bonus investment when they get others to join. And users can set up a reoccurring investment

- 1 Enable a roundup on any purchase
- 2 Enlist other people to use the app for additional \$\$
- 3 Enable a reoccurring donations









- Enables rounding up purchases w/ multipliers
- Has reoccurring savings option
- Gives you \$ for others you get to sign up

Callout - Concern

- Can not donate to anyone but yourself
- Invests not just saves so it has risk
- Fees for low savings amount

- Would it be hard to add a round up feature?
- Would investing donations be too risky?

- Is there security issues w/ rounding up?
- Fees for low balances would be annoying


Apple Wallet


Allows your mobile device to be a digital wallet, ticket holder, ID holder


Wallet for Payments

Storing credit cards in your Apple wallet with the ability to store your PAY PAL or Venmo info would be great in order to make a donation without having to be connected to the internet

- 1 Callout 1 All previous events shown provides a record
- 2 Callout 2 Ability to add cards manually or scanning
- 3 Callout 3 Ability to tap & donate at live events










- Allows you to store your payment options

- Shows past events stored as tickets

Wallet currently does not store Venmo ID info




Donate money without fees digitally both in person and virtually


